

PE and Sport Premium Allocation

In 2016-2017 we received £8320 and spent £7480.58.

This was spent in the following ways:

- Affiliation, membership and competition entry fees
- Transport
- Playground equipment
- Sports equipment
- Festivals
- Dance and drama workshops
- To help subsidise outward bound activities on residentials
- PIYO sessions
- Specialist coaches/teachers
- Trophies

Children took part in a wide variety of sports including: trampolining, badminton, tag rugby, swimming, squash, gymnastics, cricket, tennis and football.

We continue to be successful in a wide range of competitions.

Children, staff and parents are regularly asked for feedback so we can decide how best to spend our money for the following year.

In 2017-2018 we are due to receive £16,640.

We plan to spend it in many of the ways listed above.

One of the main changes we have made is that we have engaged the services of an extra specialist PE teacher from the local secondary school. On reviewing last year's work with RH there was such a positive impact on the children's attainment, enjoyment and participation we decided to extend this for year 17-18 so that more classes can benefit from this. We will therefore have OB coming from a different secondary school. Specialist teachers and coaches continue to have a sustained impact on developing our own teachers' skills.

We are going to spend a substantial amount on improving our gymnastics equipment including leotards so more children can enter the competition.
